

Dimitrios G. Goulis

Dr. Dimitrios G. Goulis completed his basic medical training (M.D.) in the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki and received his Ph.D. degree from the same University. Having a scholarship from the European Union, he worked for four years (1996 - 2000) as clinical research fellow at St. Mary and Hammersmith Hospitals, London, UK, acquiring the specialty of Endocrinology, Diabetes and Metabolism. He is currently associate professor of Reproductive Endocrinology in Aristotle University of Thessaloniki. Dr. Goulis has published more than 140 full papers in peer-review international journals and 130 in Greek journals. He was an invited speaker in more than 250 Greek and international congresses and seminars. He has been associate editor of "Human Reproduction", "Andrology", "Journal of Endocrinological Investigation", "Hormones" and "Anir". He is currently president of the Hellenic Society of Andrology (2015 – 2017) and general secretary of the executive council of the European Academy of Andrology (2014 – 2018). His main research interests include male infertility (anti-Müllerian hormone and inhibin-B, sperm DNA fragmentation, lifestyle modifications), endocrine complications of pregnancy (gestational diabetes, thyroid disease, vitamin D deficiency in pregnancy), and polycystic ovary syndrome (metabolic syndrome in women with PCOS).
