



Djuro Macut is Full Professor of Internal Medicine and Endocrinology at the Belgrade University Faculty of Medicine, Belgrade, Serbia. Dr Macut was on clinical programs at the University Hospitals in Bologna, Uppsala and Oxford, and completed postgraduate program in Reproductive Medicine from the University of Geneva and World Health Organization. Dr Macut is Head of Department of Endocrine Tumors and Hereditary Cancer Syndromes, and Deputy Director of the Clinic of Endocrinology, Diabetes and Metabolic Diseases, University Clinical Center of Serbia. Dr Macut is Visiting Professor at the Athens University School of Medicine, Greece, and Faculty of Medicine, University of Skopje, North Macedonia.

His research interests are related to reproductive endocrinology with special focus on polycystic ovary syndrome (PCOS) and insulin resistance, as well to neuroendocrinology and neuroendocrine tumors. He is as an Associate Editor of international journals *Hormones and Endocrine*.

Since 2020 is elected member of the European Society of Endocrinology (ESE) Executive Committee and ESE Treasurer. He was a member of the POC for the European Congress of Endocrinology (ECE) in Lisbon (2017) and Barcelona (2018).

Dr Macut is president of the Serbian Society for Reproductive Endocrinology, founder and organizer of the International Symposium on Advances in PCOS and Women's Health since 2012, and Belgrade Masterclass in Clinical Endocrinology, Diabetes and Metabolism since 2019.
