



Cesar Luiz Boguszewski earned his medical degree from the Federal University of Parana, Curitiba, Brazil, in 1987, where he completed his medical training in Internal Medicine and Endocrinology and obtained his degree in Master of Sciences. After that, he obtained the National Board Certificate in Clinical Endocrinology by the Brazilian Society of Endocrinology and Metabolism. Between 1994 and 1997 he worked at the Research Center for Endocrinology and Metabolism, Sahlgrenska University Hospital, Gothenburg, Sweden, where he obtained a PhD in Endocrinology, under mentorship of Professor Olle Isaksson and Professor Lena Carlsson. He is now Full Professor of Endocrinology at the

Department of Internal Medicine and Head of the Neuroendocrinology Unit, Endocrine Division (SEMPR) of the Medical School of the Federal University of Parana, Curitiba, Brazil. He is currently the President of the Brazilian Society of Endocrinology and Metabolism (SBEM) for the term 2021-2022. He was member of the Board of Directors of the Endocrine Society (2017-2020) and of the Pituitary Society (2014-2017), Dr. Boguszewski served as Associate Editor of the *European Journal of Endocrinology* between 2013-2021 and serves - or served - on the Editorial Boards or Invited Editor of *Reviews In Endocrinology and Metabolism Disorders*, *Current Opinion in Endocrine and Metabolic Research*, *Endocrine*, *Journal of Clinical Investigation*, *Frontiers in Endocrinology* and *Archives of Endocrinology and Metabolism*. He has published over 130 articles and has contributed with several book chapters. His main research areas are pituitary diseases, neuroendocrine regulation of obesity and bone metabolism.
